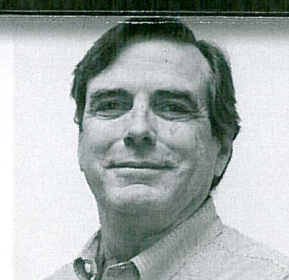
**Stephen Basila**
